FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

SEPTEMBER 1, 2020

On August 17, 2020, President Donald J. Trump granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Iowa triggering the release of Federal funds to help people and communities recover from Severe Storms that occurred on August 10, 2020. **This disaster declaration has been amended as indicated below in bold.** Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Incident: Severe Storms

Incident Period: August 10, 2020

Individual Assistance (IA): (Assistance to individuals and households):

IA-Designated Areas: Benton, Boone, Cedar, Jasper, Linn, Marshall, Polk, Poweshiek, Scott, Story, and Tama Counties.

Public Assistance (PA): (Assistance for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities):

PA-Designated Areas: Benton, Boone, Cedar, Clinton, Dallas, Jasper, Johnson, Jones, Linn, Marshall, Muscatine, Polk,

Poweshiek, Scott, Story, and Tama Counties.

Hazard Mitigation (HM):

(Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long term risk to life and property from natural hazards):

HM-Designated Areas:

All areas in the State of Iowa are eligible for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER:

Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the State and warranted by the results of further assessments.
